AWARDS PROGRAM

The Navy League's awards program offers much-deserved recognition to men and women of the sea services and those who make their success possible. More than 40 awards are given annually for professional excellence and academic achievement at the three service academies and the institutes for advanced studies, such as the Naval War College. Over 150 awards are given annually to the top graduating recruit as demonstrated through excellence during the Navy, Marine Corps and Coast Guard boot camps.

During the Sea-Air-Space Exposition, the Navy League recognizes leaders of the sea services, industry and civilian scientists and innovators who have made outstanding contributions to the nation's defense and in support of the sea services. Additionally, ideas and programs that reduce avoidable injuries and fatalities are recognized and presented to an individual and naval unit.

The Navy League President's Circle recognizes faithful supporters who make annual gifts of \$1,000 or more. President's Circle members receive invitations to all Navy League-sponsored events and select ship commissionings, as well as a customized President's Circle Pin, recognition in *Seapower* magazine and at Navy League Headquarters, and a yearly recognition gift from the Navy League.

YOUTH PROGRAMS

Navy League Foundation

One of the most rewarding programs of the Navy League is the opportunity to support the Scholarship program through the Navy League Foundation. The Navy League understands the importance of education and annually awards more than \$50,000 in scholarships and awards. The 501(c)(3) Foundation was established to expand the number of scholarships awarded annually. Recipients must be Sea Cadets or children or grandchildren of sea service families, U.S. citizens, and demonstrate both financial need and academic achievement.

STEM Institute

The Navy League of the United States has established the Navy League STEM Institute, which fosters hands-on science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) learning in informal settings for youth in grades five through 12. Through partnerships with Seaperch, eMentor and Explore Learning, we have developed a two-part program. The Engineering Room provides hands-on STEM activities in an informal educational setting. The Bridge Portal is an online mentoring program with monthly activities for the mentor and protégé to complete together.

ADVOCACY

The Navy League serves as a public voice for the sea service community. It brings together many military and veterans' service organizations for mutual achievement of goals regarding legislative, regulatory and educational concerns vital to the sea services. It is committed to educating members of Congress about the needs of the sea services and how they impact U.S. national security and the global economy. Navy League staff and members regularly visit congressional representatives and their staffs as well as sponsor receptions and briefings to provide information on current maritime issues.

ANNUAL FUND

The Navy League's leadership has recognized that private giving holds the key to transforming the organization. The organization's development history has been accomplished through annual giving efforts. This program ensures that funding is available to provide support in areas of need as established by the Board of Directors.

1902 SOCIETY
