RMKS/1. THE ADMIRAL VERN CLARK AND GENERAL JAMES L. JONES
SAFETY AWARDS WERE ESTABLISHED BY THE NAVY LEAGUE OF THE
UNITED STATES TO RECOGNIZE DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY GROUPS
OR INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE SIGNIFICANTLY IMPROVED THE SAFETY
CULTURE WITHIN THE NAVY OR MARINE CORPS.

2. A MINIMUM OF TWO SAFETY AWARDS, ONE NAVY AND ONE MARINE
CORPS, ARE PRESENTED ANNUALLY TO RECOGNIZE INNOVATIVE ACTIONS,
EXAMPLES OR SUGGESTIONS THAT HAVE REDUCED FATALITIES AND OR
MISHAPS AMONG SAILORS, MARINES OR CIVILIANS WITHIN THE DON.
MORE THAN ONE WINNER OF EACH AWARD MAY BE SELECTED AT THE
DISCRETION OF THE NAVY LEAGUE AWARDS SELECTION BOARD BASED ON
THE NUMBER AND QUALITY OF NOMINATIONS RECEIVED. IN ADDITION
TO BEING RECOGNIZED FOR THEIR COMMITMENT TO SAFETY EXCELLENCE
AND THE NAVY OR MARINE CORPS, AWARDEES WILL RECEIVE A
COMMEMORATIVE AND A CASH AWARD.
