Part I Eligibility:

The Scholarship Committee will consider each completed application for all available scholarships.

To be eligible for a Navy League Foundation Scholarship, applicants must:

Be a United States citizen.

Be a dependant or direct descendant of an active, reserve, retired or honorably discharged member of the U.S. Navy, Coast Guard, U.S.-flag Merchant Marine, Marine Corps or U.S. Naval Sea Cadet Corps.

Will complete final year High School or equivalent during 2007-2008 school year.

Will enter an accredited College/University in 2008.

Part III Addendum Information and Attachments:

All component parts of the application must be completed and sent in one package. The committee will not consider incomplete applications. Illegible applications will not be reviewed. Type or print clearly. Your application package must include the following attachments:

Copies of all applicable transcripts (grade 9 through present)

Up to TWO recommendations

SAT/ACT scores (a copy of the unofficial report will suffice)

__ FAFSA information (full report including Expected Family Contribution “EFC” is preferred, however if report is not available a copy of the completed application including parents’ AGI will suffice)

__ Proof of qualifying sea service duty (discharge papers, military/dependant’s ID, etc)

__ One-page personal statement answering “Why I should be considered for a Navy League Foundation Scholarship.”

__ You may include up to TWO additional sheets to list scholastic/extracurricular activities.

Awardees will be notified of the committee’s decision by May 1, 2008. Due to the volume of applications, we regret we are unable to notify all applicants of their status.
