SUPPORT THE YOUTH OF THE SEA SERVICES

The Navy League Foundation exists through generous donations helping to defray the cost of college educations for the children of sea service families. The Navy League Foundation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, for which donations are tax deductible.

A robust pool of privately funded scholarships is essential to the Navy League's ability to support the children of the sea services. Donor-supported scholarships have made a huge impact on the lives of hundreds of our sea services' youth since 1999. We want to make a bigger impact by expanding the number of scholarships available as well as increase the amount of each scholarship.

ESTABLISH A SCHOLARSHIP

All Navy League Foundation Scholarships are endowed with a minimum donation of \$50,000. Scholarships can be used to memorialize a loved one, or a group can pool their donations to create a scholarship. A Navy League Council can create a scholarship in the name of their council, or perhaps to honor and remember a council member who's support of the council is worthy of remembrance.

The endowment need not be paid at one time. Pledge options are available to spread donations over five years. The scholarship will not be awarded until the endowment is complete, unless additional annual donations of \$2,500 are made to facilitate immediate awarding.

If desired, additional restrictions may be placed on the scholarship, i.e. geographic area or area of academic study to tailor the scholarship. This ensures an impact is made in an area that matches a donor's investment with their passion.

ABOUT THE FOUNDATION

It is becoming increasingly difficult for students to afford access to quality higher education. Tuition is rising faster than most families can afford. Scholarships reduce the financial strain and allow the student to focus more on academics rather than trying to balance work and class. The Navy League Foundation makes this possible through scholarships to sea service families.

The Navy League Foundation awards scholarships to graduating high school seniors who are entering attend college in the fall. Navy League Foundation Scholarships are available only to Sea Cadets and to children and grandchildren of former members of the sea services and those currently serving. Scholarships are awarded for four years and provide an award of \$2,500 per year — \$10,000 total — as long as the recipient maintains a 3.0 grade point average.
