Alaska Sea Service Scholarship

Amount: \$1,000 annual awards

Number of Awards: 4

<u>Awarding criteria</u>: The recipient of this award will be an undergrad student and the dependent child or spouse of Navy, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard personnel who legally claim Alaska as their state of residence.

Jack and Eileen Anderson Scholarship

Amount: \$10,000 over four years

<u>Awarding criteria</u>: The recipient of this award will be a student properly enrolled in any curriculum at an accredited institution of higher education who is the child or grandchild of a member of the sea services, to include the United States Navy, United States Marine Corps, United States Coast Guard, and U.S.-flag Merchant Marine. In all other respects, these funds will be awarded without restriction to race, gender, national origin, religion, age sexual orientation, or disability.

Jewell H. Bonner Scholarship

Amount: \$10,000 over four years

Awarding criteria: The recipient of this award will be a student properly enrolled in any curriculum at an accredited institution of higher education who is the child or grandchild of a member of the sea services, to include the United States Navy, United States Marine Corps, United States Coast Guard, and U.S.-flag Merchant Marine. Preference is given to an applicant with a Native American heritage. In all other respects, these funds will be awarded without restriction to race, gender, national origin, religion, age sexual orientation, or disability.

John G. Brokaw Scholarship

Amount: \$10;000 over four years

In all other respects, these funds will be awarded without restriction to race, gender, national origin, religion, age sexual orientation, or disability.

RADM William A. Sullivan, USN (Ret) Scholarship

Amount: \$10,000 over four years

Number of Awards: 4

Awarding criteria: The recipient of this award will be a student properly enrolled in any curriculum at an accredited institution of higher education who is the child or grandchild of a member of the sea services, to include the United States Navy, United States Marine Corps, United States Coast Guard, and U.S.-flag Merchant Marine. Preference is given to applicants who will seek a degree in science or engineering. Preference is given to applicants who currently reside in San Diego, California. In all other respects, these funds will be awarded without restriction to race, gender, national origin, religion, age sexual orientation, or disability.

United Armed Forces Association Scholarship

Amount: \$10,000 over four years

<u>Awarding criteria</u>: The recipient of this award will be a student properly enrolled in any curriculum at an accredited institution of higher education who is the child or grandchild of a member of the sea services, to include the United States Navy, United States Marine Corps, United States Coast Guard, and U.S.-flag Merchant Marine. In all other respects, these funds will be awarded without restriction *to* race, gender, national origin, religion, age sexual orientation, or disability.
