Before his tenure at the Navy League, Mike was the Chief Executive Officer of Victory Media, a military-focused digital and print media marketing company that specializes in promoting veterans' employment opportunities.

Mike has also contributed to the National Academy of Sciences, serving as the Vice Chair of the Naval Studies Board, and has been a guest lecturer at the Naval Postgraduate School.

He has a rich history of service on various boards, including the Association of the United States Navy (AUSN), where he was a member of the board of directors and served as Chairman of AUSN's Anchor Society. Additionally, he has served as a board adviser for the National Museum of the American Sailor and the Global War on Terror Memorial Foundation.

Throughout his 33-year Navy career, Mike held roles as a technical expert, manager, and senior enlisted leader across multiple operational and shore assignments.

Mike's academic credentials include a Bachelor of Science degree from Excelsior College, completion of the Harvard John F. Kennedy School of Government's "Leadership in Crisis" program, certification as a Six Sigma Black Belt, and participation in Senior Enlisted Professional Military Education, Senior Enlisted Joint Professional Military Education, and the National Defense University Keystone course. He is proud to be an honor graduate and has been awarded the prestigious Peter Tomich Award for exceptional military excellence from the Senior Enlisted Academy.

His personal awards reflect his dedication and service, including the Navy Distinguished Service Medal, Legion of Merit, three Meritorious Service Medals, four Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medals, six Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medals, and the Coast Guard Achievement Medal (Operational O).
